

Included components:

Unit ships fully assembled

Tools required:

- Non-corrosive anchoring hardware, if specified. (2) required per unit. Maximum 3/8" diameter.
- Flat head screwdriver for adjusting glides

INSTALLATION:

- 1. Set unit in position.
- 2. Level unit if necessary. Open door and remove liner. Adjust glides using flat head screwdriver.

CONTINUE FOR SURFACE MOUNT INSTALLATION:

- 3. Mark hole locations. Larger 1/2" diameter holes are for surface mounting. Smaller 5/16" diameter holes are drain holes.
- 4. Move unit and drill holes according to anchor manufacturer's recommendations. See Fig. 3 for base casting dimensions. Dimensions apply to all unit sizes. See product drawings for center to center hole spacing.
- Set unit back in place and install anchors according to anchor manufacturer's recommendations.

ASSEMBLE WITH CARE! Pangard II® Polyester Powdercoat is a strong, long-lasting finish. To protect this finish during assembly, place unwrapped powdercoated parts on packaging foam or other non-marring surface. Do not place or slide powdercoated parts on concrete or other hard or textured surface — this will damage the finish causing rust to occur. Use touch-up paint on any gouges in the finish caused by assembly tools.




Fig. 1 – Bottom view of single unit base




Fig. 2 – Base view showing tops of glides




Fig. 3 – Section view of single unit base
