Not your old guard, Sentinel is a totally 21st century bollard designed to complement contemporary architecture. Standard-size mitre mount on 6" diameter structural pipes.

Bollard

- Sentinel bollard: cast aluminum sleeve mounts over supplied 6" structural steel pipe and secures with concealed hardware.
- Bollard may be specified to embed, surface mount or removable.

Mounting

Embedded

- This is the strongest and most common method for installation.
- The steel post is set into an 18" concrete footing.
- The steel post is set directly into the concrete.
- The aluminum bollard is slipped over the top of the base plate and locked into place by a draw ring which aids in orientation.

Surface Mount


- A steel base plate is anchored to the concrete in four locations.
- The steel base plate helps align and aid installation.
- The aluminum bollard is slipped over the top of the base plate and locked into place by a draw ring which aids in orientation.

Removable

- The removable version aesthetically matches embedded and surface mount versions.
- A galvanized socket is embedded in concrete.
- The steel post is inserted into the socket, and secured with a locking mechanism.
- The aluminum bollard is slipped over the top of the base plate and locked into place by a draw ring which aids in orientation.

Finishes

- All metal is finished with Landscape Forms' proprietary Pangard II® polyester powdercoat, a hard yet flexible finish that resists rusting, chipping, peeling and fading.
